A high rank military from Genoa, named Nino Bixio, was fighting at the time alongside Garibaldi in the battle of Custoza, near Verona, on 24th June 1866. After the glorious battle he met and entertained a relationship with a local noble woman that gave him a child, named Alfonso who later managed to acquire some vineyards in the area that today is the classic-area of Soave. Today, the Azienda Agricola Bixio is a modern reality in the wine landscape who not only embraces and promotes the traditional products of the area, but also uses the latest technology.

The different interpretations of Amarone are always wonderful stages of a pleasant journey. Today, finding a shared model among different wineries has become very difficult because each one has its personal perception of Amarone. Bixio undoubtedly prefers one with sweeter, softer hints. The aroma is "warm", with black cherries in alcohol undertones in a vanilla weave. The taste is captivating, silky even though its structure is not so imposing. The Amarone is excellent with meat recipes, pot roasts especially.

The Ripasso success knows no boundaries and is one of the most trendy Italian wines on the market for many years now. What the Poderi Bixio winery produced is intriguing because it is a very balanced Ripasso, not excessively strong, with a cooked plums and vanilla aroma and a taste which has an important yet gentle structure and an excellent sapidity. All of which makes it perfect for meat recipes, such as pot roasts.
